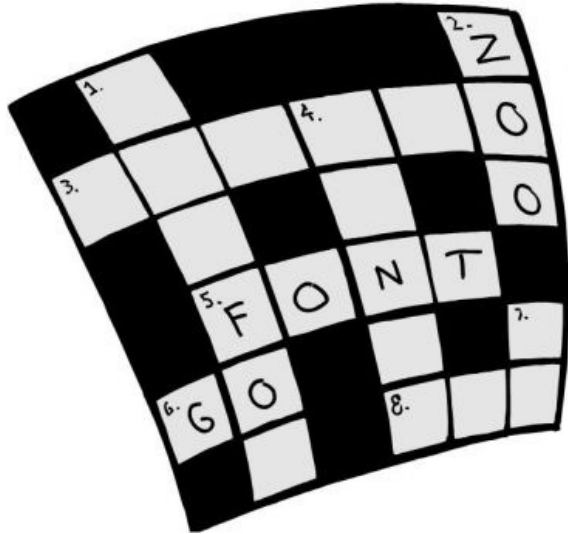


Take the Eco-Challenge in Honor of Earth Day 2010
